- Erected the first Ferris Wheel
- Invented the first successful machine for testing the blood alcohol level in humans
- Wrote the first message sent by telegraph
- First automatic traffic light in America
- The first city in the nation to have electric street lighting (Wabash)
- The first state to adopt reflective yellow lines for highways
- First woman in the nation to make a public solo flight
- First aviator to do skywriting
- The first long-distance auto race in the U.S. was held May 30, 1911 at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway
