- Alaska has 3 million lakes. ...
- Alaska has more than 12,000 rivers. ...
- Alaska has an estimated 100,000 glaciers. ...
- Alaska has more volcanoes than any other state. ...
- Alaska has 54,563 kilometers of tidal shoreline.
- Alaska has 17 of the 20 highest mountains in North America. The Denali is the tallest mountain at 20,310 ft.
- Alaska ranks 48th in the nation in population. Their 735,720 residents roughly equals 1.2 people per square mile!
- They have their own holidays. Alaskans celebrate Seward's Day the last Monday in March to commemorate the Alaska Territory's purchase from the Russians in 1867 and Alaska Day on October 18, the day Alaska was officially transferred from Russia to the United States.
 - Juneau their state capital is the only U.S. state capital that is not accessible by road.
- They have rich oil reserves. In 1977, the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System (we call it TAPS for short) has transported more than 18 billion barrels of oil from Alaska's Arctic North Slope to Southcentral Valdez a distance of 800 miles.
- Jun 1, 2021 President Biden on Tuesday suspended oil and gas leases in Alaska's
 Arctic National Wildlife Refuge, reversing a drilling program approved by the Trump
 Administration
- Alaska has the only temperate rainforest in the United States. At 16.8 million acres, the Tongass National Forest in Alaska's Inside Passage is also the country's largest national forest.
